

First of all my warm wishes for the New Year 2015.

Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has launched a Scheme named as "Dr. Ambedkar Central Sector Scheme of Interest Subsidy on Educational Loan for Overseas Studies for Economically Backward Classes (EBC)" and two schemes namely Dr. Ambedkar Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pre-matric & Post-matric Scholarship Scheme for DNTs and Nanaji Deshmukh Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Construction of Hostels for DNTs. Under the Scheme for EBCs, Ministry will provide the interest subsidy for the moratorium period on the Education Loan taken under Education Loan Scheme of Indian Banks Association (IBA) for pursuing higher education abroad. Under the schemes for DNTs Pre-matric & Post-matric will be provided for those DNT students which are not covered under any other scholarship schemes for SCs/STs/OBCs. Hostel scheme for DNTs

Dr. Ambedkar Post-Matric Scholarship for the Economically Backward Class Students
(Centrally Sponsored Scheme)

(Effective from 2014-15)

I. OBJECTIVE

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the Economically Backward Class (EBC) students studying at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.

II. SCOPE

These scholarships shall be available for studies in India only and will be awarded by the Government of State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs, i.e. permanently settled.

III. CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

- i. The scholarships will be open to Indian nationals belonging to General Category (Other than Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe and Other Backward Classes) and the total income from all sources of the employed candidate or his/her parents/guardians in case of unemployed candidate shall not exceed Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum.
- ii. Income certificate should be submitted from the competent authority in the State/Union Territory
- iii. These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized institutions with the following exceptions:
 "Scholarships shall not be awarded for training courses like Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Course and Private Pilot License Courses, Courses at Training-Ship Dufferin (Now Rejendra); Courses of training at the Military College, Dehradun, Courses at pre-examination Training Centres of All India and State levels."
- iv. Candidates who, after passing one stage of education, are studying in the same stage of education in different subject e.g. I. Sc. after I.A or B.Com. after B.A. or M.A. in a subject after M.A in another subject will not be eligible.
- v. Students who, after having completed their educational career in one professional line, e.g., LLB after B.T/B. Ed will not be eligible.

sad incidence takes place. Applications for scholarships from such students can be considered even after lapse of last date of receipt of applications, on compassionate grounds.

Note 2: House Rent Allowance received by the parents of a student be exempted from the computation of 'income' if the same has been permitted to be exempted for purpose of Income-Tax.

Note 3: Income Certificate is required to be taken once only, i.e. at the time of admission to courses, which are continuing for more than one year.

IV. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The value of scholarship will include Maintenance Allowance, Reader Charges for blind students, reimbursement of compulsory non-refundable fees, Study Tour Charges/thesis typing/printing charges and book allowance for students pursuing correspondence course, for complete duration of the course as per details given below:-

Note: 1 Commercial Pilot License Course(CPL)

CPL course shall be covered under Group 'A'. The number of awards for CPL will be 20 per annum. Consequent upon receiving applications from concerned students, concerned State Governments/UT Adms., should scrutinize them for determining their eligibility under the Scheme and thereafter intimate the number of eligible applications for CPL training (with their names) for each financial year to Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (their applications need not be sent to the Ministry). Upon receipt of such information, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment will give clearance to the concerned States/UTs on the first come first-serve basis upto 20 awards for the country as a whole. The selected candidates will be provided a maintenance allowance at rates applicable to Group 'A' courses, i.e. Rs. 750 per month for hostlers and Rs. 350 per month for day scholars. In addition, an amount of Rs.5000/- per flying hour in single/multiengine aircraft for 200 hours will be paid. No other component of expenditure will be admissible for CPL courses under the scheme. The expenditure of the selected candidates will be paid/borne by the concerned State Government/UT Admn. out of their central allocation of funds.

Note 2: Scholars who are entitled to free boarding and/or lodging will be paid maintenance chargers at 1/3rd of hostellers' rate.

ii) Reader Charges for blind students (Blind Scholars)

The blind scholars will be given additional amount as 'Readers Charges' as mentioned below:-

iii) Fees

Scholars will be paid enrolment/registration, tuition, games, union, library, magazine, medical examination and such other fees compulsorily payable by the scholar to the institution or university/Board. Refundable deposit-like caution money, security deposit will, however, be excluded.

- ii. In case of renewal of scholarships awarded in the previous years, maintenance charges will be paid from the month following the month up to which scholarship was paid in the previous year, if the course of study is continuous.
- iii. All scholars are expected to purchase the necessary text books, stationary etc., out of the maintenance allowance sanctioned. If it is reported by the Head of the concerned Institution that a scholar is without text-books stationary etc., the value of the scholarship may be reduced at the discretion of the authority sanctioning the scholarship.
- iv. The scholarship money will be paid to the selected students by the government of the State/Union Territory's Administration to which they belong in accordance with the procedure laid down by them in this regard.
- v. Scholarship will not be paid for the period of internship/ housemanship in the M.B.B.S. course or for a practical training in other course if the student is in receipt of some remuneration during the internship period or some allowance/stipend during the practical training in other course.

VIII. MODE OF DISBURSAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

In order to ensure timely payment of scholarship amount to the beneficiaries, the State Government/UT administrations are requested to avoid cash payment of scholarship amount and are required to issue instructions to all concerned that payment of scholarship should be made directly to beneficiaries through their accounts in post offices/banks with phased transition to Smart Cards.

IX. OTHER CONDITIONS FOR THE AWARD

- i. The scholarship is dependent on the satisfactory progress and conduct of the scholars. If it is reported by the Head of the Institution at any time that a scholar has, by reasons of his/her own act or default, failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strikes, irregularity in attendance without the permission of the authorities concerned etc., the authority sanctioning the scholarships may either cancel the scholarships or stop or withhold further payment of such period as it may think fit.
- ii. If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered, at the discretion of the concerned State Government. The student concerned will be blacklisted and debarred for scholarship in any scheme for ever.
- iii. A scholarship awarded may be cancelled if the scholar changes the subject of the course of study for which the scholarship were originally awarded or changes the institution of study, without prior approval of the State Government. The Head of the Institution shall report such cases to them and stop payment of the scholarship money. The amount already paid may also be recovered at the discretion of the State Government.
- iv. A scholar is liable to refund the scholarship amount at the discretion of the State Government, if during the course of the year, the studies for which the scholarship has been awarded, is discontinued by him/her.
- v. The provisions of the scheme can be changed at any time at the discretion of the Government of India.

X. ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE SCHEME

- iv. States/UTs will incur expenditure under the Scheme at least to the extent of "Central assistance or NA plus their committed liability", and should normally limit the number of scholarships accordingly. However, they would be free to allocate funds from the State-Plan, over and above the level of their committed liability plus the Central Assistance received, for funding additional scholarships under the Scheme. Any such additional expenditure will have to be borne by the State Government/UT Administration itself, over and above their committed liability, and will generally not be eligible for reimbursement from the Centre. However, additional expenditure incurred by a State/UT beyond the level of Central Assistance may be considered for reimbursement by the Central Government, to the extent of availability of savings (mainly from States which are not able to fully avail of their notional allocation, for any reason), towards the end of a financial year.
- v. Central assistance given to a State/UT would have to be first utilized to cover renewal cases (i.e. students already awarded scholarships during the previous years against Central Assistance), and only the balance amount left may be utilized to cover new cases.

The above lays down the broad principles and procedure for implementing the "Capping" feature. Each State Government may work out its State-specific detailed modalities for implementing the Capping feature of the PMS-EBC Scheme, keeping in view the above broad principles/ procedure and its own circumstances, and send to this Ministry guidelines issued and any amendments thereto, in this behalf to the implementing agencies.

XIII. FUNDING PATTERN OF THE SCHEME

The Scheme will be implemented by the State Governments and Union Territories, which will receive 100% central assistance from Government of India under the Scheme. 1% of the funds will be utilized for administrative expenses.

XIV. MONITORING

The monitoring of the financial and physical performance of the Scheme will be done through seeking detailed information from the Agencies implementing the Scheme. On the physical aspects the Agencies implementing the Scheme will be required to furnish Quarterly Progress Reports regarding the number of beneficiaries receiving award under the Scheme, both class-wise and gender-wise. On the financial side, details of actual expenditure incurred during the last financial year and expenditure proposed for the present financial year will be submitted by the Agencies concerned. The Agencies implementing the scheme will also be insisted upon to submit the latest audited accounts.

XV. EVALAUTION

The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment may get the scheme evaluated by entrusting a research study to reputed institutions/agencies, on the performance of the Scheme in different parts of the country, under this Ministry's Scheme of Research and Training.

Dr. Ambedkar National Overseas Scholarship for Economically Backward Classes

(Centrally Sponsored Scheme)

(Effective from 2014-15)

1. Background

The scheme of Interest Subsidy on educational loans for overseas studies will promote educational advancement of student from Economically Backward Classes.

2. Objective

The objective of the scheme is to award interest subsidy to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education abroad and enhance their employability.

3. Scope

The is a Central Sector Scheme to provide interest subsidy to the student belonging to the EBCs on the interest payable for the period of moratorium for the Educational Loans under the Scheme of Interest subsidy on Educational Loans for Overseas Studies to pursue approved courses of studies abroad at Masters and Ph.D level.

4. Conditions for Interest Subsidy

- i. The Scheme is applicable for higher studies abroad. The interest Subsidy shall be linked with the existing Educational Loan Scheme of Indian Banks Association (IBA) and restricted to students enrolled for course at Masters, M.Phil and Ph.D level.
- ii. The interest subsidy under the scheme shall be available to the eligible students only once, either for Masters or Ph.D levels. Interest subsidy shall not be available to those students who either discontinued the course mid-stream due to any reason, or those who are expelled from the institutions on disciplinary or academic grounds.
- iii. If a student violates any condition of the scheme, the subsidy will be discontinued forthwith.
- iv. If a student is found to have obtained the subsidy by false statement/certificates, the subsidy will be withdrawn/ cancelled forthwith and amount of the subsidy paid shall be recovered with penal interest, apart from taking criminal action as per law.
- v. The students obtaining benefits under this Scheme shall not be given the interest subsidy if he gives up Indian citizenship during the tenure of the loan.
- vi. The designated bank will maintain a separate account and records relating to the funds received from the Ministry and these will be subject to inspection/audit by the officers of the Ministry, or any other agency designated by the Ministry and C&AG.

- iii. The candidate will bear the Principal installments and interest beyond moratorium period.

9. Implementing Agencies

The Scheme will be implemented by the designated Banks as per MoU between the Banks and the NBCFDC on behalf of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.

10. Administrative Expenses

- i. A provision not exceeding 2% of the annual budget allocation for the scheme will be made to meet the administrative and allied costs viz. expenditure of the Ministry for office equipments, including computers and accessories, advertisements, engagement of personnel, third party evaluation etc.
- ii. This provision will also be used for evaluation and monitoring of the scheme, through outside reputed institutions/agencies engaged by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. Administrative cost of the Banks will be shared as per provision in the MoU.

11. Monitoring and Transparency

- i. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment shall monitor the performance of the scheme.
- ii. For this purpose, a web enabled monitoring mechanism shall be put in place by designated Banks.
- iii. The designated Banks will be required to furnish quarterly financial and physical progress reports to the Ministry.
- iv. The designated Banks will maintain year-wise details of the students receiving scholarship, indicating institute, location of the institute, course, gender, new or renewal, permanent address and parents address.
- v. Designated Banks will place relevant physical and financial details on their official website.

12. Minor Modifications/Changes

Minor Modifications/Changes in the Scheme with no financial implications may be made by the Competent Authority.

13. Evaluation

The monitoring of the financial and physical performance of the scheme will be periodically evaluated by the assigning evaluation/impact studies to reputed institutions/agencies by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India.

Dr. Ambedkar Pre-Matric and Post-Matric Scholarship for DNTs

(Centrally Sponsored Scheme)

(Effective from 2014-15)

1. Background

The Government had constituted a National Commission for Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes headed by Shri Bal Krishna Sidram Renke in the year 2005 which submitted its Report on 2.7.2008. A draft Note for the Cabinet based on the points of convergence of the recommendations was prepared and placed before the Cabinet. The Cabinet considered the proposal and directed that an appropriate scheme for grant of pre and post-matric scholarships for students belonging to such Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes not included in the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes be framed. It has been recognized that education and economic support for Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes has not been adequate and there is disparity between the DNTs and other sections of the population at every level. In view of the same, it is felt that earnest efforts are required to introduce various new schemes specifically for this target group i.e. Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes to bring them at par with the other sections of the population.

1.2 The children from the poorer sections of DNTs do not go schools as they often have to provide a helping hand to their parents in traditional occupation or otherwise supplement the family income. A scheme of Pre-matric Scholarship would be helpful in spreading education amongst such children especially amongst the girl child of weaker sections. Accordingly, it is proposed to formulate Pre-matric Scholarship Scheme for the benefit of children belonging to DNTs.

2. Objective of the Scheme

The Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes (DNTs) have been at the peripheries of the society for a long time. While benefits of reservations, scholarships etc. were available to SCs/STs/OBCs, no such welfare schemes are available for the welfare of these DNTs i.e. those who are not covered under SC, ST or OBC. The Scheme is for bringing about a focused intervention on these classes so that they are empowered socially and economically and their lives are also improved. This scheme will be of continuous and permanent nature.

5. The timeline for the implementation of the proposed schemes is as under:

- 5.1 The welfare schemes for the DNTs are to be implemented through allocation of funds to the State Governments in proportion to their DNT population. As per requirement for the new scheme, the ratio of State and Centre would be 25:75 for funding. The concept of committed liability would hence not be applied to this scheme. - 5.2 In order to ensure timely payment of scholarship amount to the Aadhar linked beneficiaries, the payment of scholarship should only be made in **Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode so that the scholarship is credited directly to Aadhaar Linked Bank Accounts of the beneficiaries. Nanaji Deshmukh Scheme of Construction of Hostels for DNTs' Boys and Girls
(Centrally Sponsored Scheme)

(Effective from 2014-15)

1. Background

The Government had constituted a National Commission for Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes headed by Shri Bal Krishna Sidram Renke in the year 2005 which submitted its Report, on 2.7.2008. A draft Note for the Cabinet based on the points of convergence of the recommendations was prepared and placed before the Cabinet. The Cabinet considered the proposal and directed that an appropriate scheme for construction of hostels for students belonging to such Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes not included in the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes be framed. It has been recognized that education and economic support for Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes has not been adequate and there is disparity between the DNTs and other sections of the population at every level. In view of the same, it is felt that earnest efforts are required to introduce various new schemes specifically for this target group i.e. Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes to bring them at par with the other sections of the population.

2. Objective of the Scheme

The Denotified and Nomadic Tribes (DNTs) have been at the peripheries of the society for a long time. While benefits of reservations, scholarships etc. were available to SCs/STs/OBCs, no such welfare schemes are available for the welfare of these DNTs i.e. those who are not covered under SC, ST or OBC. The Scheme is for bringing about a focused intervention on these classes so that they are empowered socially and economically and their lives are also improved. These schemes will be of continuous and permanent nature.

2.2 The hostels would be constructed as an additional support to the existing hostels for the SCs/OBCs/General category students. However, the construction of the hostels would be done on a pro-rata basis based on the number of seats for the target group. Construction of hostels would be done in conjugation with other similar hostel schemes being implemented by this Ministry and other

- c. Besides, all Ministries/Departments of Government of India will be requested to include DNTs in their Welfare Schemes.
- d. The income limit of Rs. 2 Lakh per annum (i.e. combined income of husband and wife) will be valid for the purpose of identification of DNT beneficiaries.
- e. States would be given allocation of funds in proportion to their DNT population.

Once the funds become available to the Ministry, these will be transferred to the respective State Governments for implementation at the field level.
